## A Symphony

There was a moment of silence on the phone. And then the soft-spoken words, “That’s beautiful.” Judith Costa had just heard a line of the Christian song, *Symphony*: Through all of this chaos, You are writing a symphony.

It’s no wonder that sentence touched her heart; Judy is a living symphony. But her early childhood was a dissonant clash of adversity, pain, and yes, chaos.

Until the grace of God intervened.

Now, decades later, she fully believes that her trials helped her to “empathize with people” and prepared her to walk with others on their healing journey. In a sense, you might say her childhood paved the way for her work in Rachel’s Vineyard.

But years before she learned about the ministry, Judy discovered the Charismatic Renewal. The power of the Holy Spirit, spirit-filled friends, and prayer helped jump-start her healing process. God began weaving a melody of confidence and hope into her life, even in times of discordant clamor.

“The Holy Spirit also puts certain people in our path, so you need to be prepared to trust God,” she says wisely. And Judy speaks from experience. God put Lou, a young man who was discerning a Naval military career, in her path while she was young. They married, had seven children, and spent almost a decade stationed in California and Japan.

When her family returned to the States from overseas, Roe vs. Wade had just passed. It wasn’t long before Judy learned about a friend’s abortion. The effects of “Jane’s” abortion were devastating. “She wasn’t as emotionally strong as she was before,” Judy commented, “then she attempted suicide.” Shortly after that, another friend had an abortion. Unfortunately, this younger friend developed uterine cancer, and her inability to have children left her with years and years of heartache.

Judy wasn’t sure how to handle the subject with her friends, but she could see the trail of damage abortion left behind. When she heard that Theresa Burke was coming to Rhode Island to talk about Rachel’s Vineyard, Judy and her friend, Sr. Joyce, jumped at the opportunity to attend. Soon after, the Diocese of Providence started a Rachel’s Vineyard team, so they both eagerly joined. That was in 1999; she’s never looked back.


Rhode Island’s retreats are held right across the border in Connecticut. Their distinctive flair is how they run their retreats. The retreat house is large enough to run the English and Spanish retreats separately but on the same grounds. Both retreats have their own assigned priest, but participants and team members come together for Mass and meals, so they mingle and support one another. Frequently, they ask one another for prayers. “Our teams work very well together,” Judy says appreciatively. “They are very prayerful and kind.” This beautiful harmony is a powerful testament of God’s Spirit helping the teams put love ahead of everything, which unites them “together in perfect unity.” (Col. 3:14)

Not surprisingly, when asked what her “trick of the trade” is for working with people of various personalities and levels of trauma, Judy stresses, “Rely on the Holy Spirit, who has His reasons for things happening the way they do.” She then


tells the story of a priest who helped on the English Retreat. His appearance was reminiscent of the hippie era and “as disheveled as he was, he was just what was needed for the people on that retreat,” Judy commented. “Everyone liked Father, but one man in particular really connected with him. This man had been baptized Catholic but was never catechized. He went to his first Confession with our ‘hippie’ priest!”

“God is good,” Judy exclaims. And she looks to St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta, Mother Angelica, and Theresa Burke as examples of trusting in His goodness. “They did not have the means of accomplishing what God was asking them to do, but they did it anyway.”

In Judy’s life, too, God has worked wonders, composing a melodious tune of trust, hope, and surrender—in times of joy and in times of great darkness. Even during the chaos, He was “writing a symphony.”

## **Effects of Pressure to Abort on Women’s Emotional Responses and Mental Health**

St. Louis, MO (Feb. 1, 2023)—Women who feel pressured to have abortions blame their abortions for a decline in their mental health, according to a new peer reviewed study. They were also more likely to say their abortions led to frequent feelings of grief, loss, and disruption of their lives and relationships.


“Over 60% of women who had abortions reported feeling high levels of pressure to abort from one or more sources,” said the lead author David Reardon. “Only 5 percent reported little or no pressure. Those who felt pressure to abort had more negative reactions across ten different scales.”

### Note from the Pastoral Director

Dear Friends,

The weather was perfect in Phoenix on Thursday, February 23 as pro-life people from around the state gathered for the Arizona March for Life.

As is the case at the national March for Life in Washington, DC each year, and at the Walk for Life West Coast in San Francisco, Rachel's Vineyard and its mission of healing was fully present, visible and active at this state march – one of various state marches taking place across the nation.

Having arrived the night before, I met up with our Phoenix Representative, Karen Ord, in the morning, and I went over to the table that was set up with our Rachel's Vineyard literature and books in the area where various pro-life ministries displayed their materials. I had some great conversations with interested high school and college students who came for the march. Right next to our Rachel's Vineyard table, appropriately, was the table for the Silent No More Awareness Campaign, which is so closely related to us.



As the day got underway, we all gathered for the Silent No More testimonies, which were beautifully done and taped for later broadcast.

At the main rally a bit later, there was an impressive number of Arizona legislators, and activists from all parts of the movement. The awareness of the damage abortion has done to moms, dads and families was very strong as people spoke from the podium, conversed with one another, and carried the usual wide variety of signs.

The Arizona Supreme Court is currently considering whether to uphold the state's pro-life law. As we know, the US Supreme Court has acknowledged the voices of those who regret their abortions. We pray the state court will have the wisdom to do the same and prevent the wounds of abortion from spreading further.

I had the opportunity to greet many of the marchers, as they processed by the hundreds. They were grateful for our presence, and renewed in their determination to stand up for the babies and their families, and to be witnesses that the Gospel of Life is the Gospel of Mercy.

Thank you, Arizona! Now it's on to California (March 6) and Connecticut (March 22)!

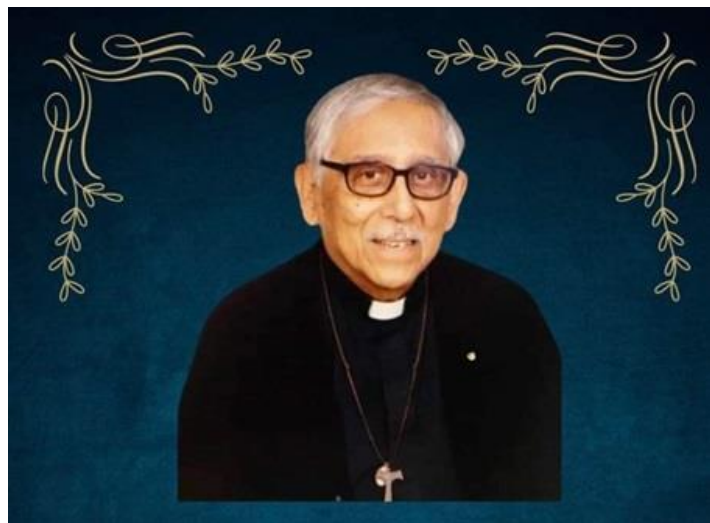
