Rachel's Vineyard Growth in Mexico

Our new site to open El Viñedo de Raquel in Queretaro, Mexico was planned for months. The retreat date was March 10-12, and we had prepared the new team (who had already done the retreat) through Zoom meetings, talked about materials needed, and discussed who would be doing the different meditations, etc.

My team and I, including one of our therapists from Bogota, Colombia (Blanca Yaneth Uribe), traveled from Palm Beach, Florida. We were so excited once again to be able to answer God's call.

We prepared everything that was needed to start a new site, first of all, the prayers. Because of the replies from the intake (registration), we knew this retreat

was going to be a very hard one. There were 18 participants, which included one couple and a few women who had at least ten abortions.

Whenever we have a retreat, we know we're going into a spiritual battle, so we go in prepared. We ask for prayers from our prayer warrior friends and get a Mass offered for our team. Then, as Catholics, we go to Mass and Adoration, pray Rosaries, and go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Even with all that, what we encountered was way beyond what we thought – the pain, shame, guilt, and trauma were unbearable. We all deal with this in our retreats, but this one was extremely difficult.

Before we started our retreat, we stopped at the Basilica of our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City. One of the team members (our new counselor, Marisol Rodriguez) was so happy to be there, she began taking pictures. Unfortunately, she didn't see a step and she fell, hurting her rib. Poor Marisol was in great pain the entire weekend.

The rest of our team got a really bad stomach bug. I have been to Mexico five times and have never gotten sick, but I had to go to bed on Saturday and couldn't get up for the rest of the day. Other team members got just as sick. Thank God, Blanca Yaneth, our facilitator, and Marisol weren't as sick, so they took over. There was a doctor participating in the retreat, so she prescribed IV fluids and antibiotics for us.

Even though we went through a lot, we believe it was all worth it because we saw God shower the participants with His love and mercy. We were able to see and experience a true MIRACLE of God's healing. Our new team handled everything with grace and love, and we are excited about the work they're doing in Queretaro.

After the retreat, we were on the plane about to return home when the captain told us there was a malfunction in the plane. We waited for hours to get another flight. By the time we arrived at Miami International airport and drove to Palm Beach, it was 3:00 in the morning, but we were home safe and sound. Thank you, Jesus, for allowing all of us to experience your presence on this retreat and protecting us in our travels!

A Servant's Heart

Maybe it's in her Polish blood. Maybe it's because she's been part of Rachel's Vineyard for more than 15 years. Maybe it stems from her love for the Catholic Faith.

Or maybe it's all of the above.

Whatever the reason, Evelyn Walsh has a servant's heart.

The youngest of four siblings, she grew up in a close-knit Polish family. Her heritage – and music – weaved together, forming a background that orchestrated her life. "I've been singing since high school," she explains, "when I was the cantor at my church." But she didn't limit herself to religious hymns only. She loved to listen to Karen Carpenter and sang along with every note, trying to imitate her voice. Later she was accepted into the Archdiocesan choir (which was audition-based), and after her three daughters were grown, she started singing Polish and Latin songs with them. Now she sings in her parish choir, with the Charismatic Renewal Prayer Group at the National Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa in Doylestown, PA, and "wherever the Lord asks [her] to lift up her voice."

The Czestochowa Shrine, too, has been an integral thread in that woven background. Going regularly since she was a child, it's her second home. In 2008, Fr. Tadeusz Lizinczyk, the American Province Superior of the Order of St. Paul the Hermit, brought Rachel's Vineyard to the Shrine. She went to the first retreat they held at the Shrine, and it didn't take long for her to become part of the team. When the team leader had to leave for personal reasons, Evelyn was asked to take on that role. "I had to pray on it," she says, recognizing the immense responsibility involved. But now, "it feels like a calling."

As a team leader, she ensures that everything is in place and runs smoothly. Theresa Burke describes their team as "a well-oiled machine." Their success is not based merely on their organizational and communication skills, though. "The team we have is family," Evelyn says, "we work well together." And when she speaks of the team, she's referring to the *entire* team, including the people who are part of hospitality and Adoration. "Hospitality and prayer are just as important as everything else," she claims.

Those aren't hollow words. Evelyn means it. The fact that previous retreatants still come for Adoration or to drop off trays of cookies proves her point. Other retreatants have written books, started ministries to support women and girls in crisis pregnancies, and have become involved with pro-life meetings. They, too, stay in touch with the Doylestown team.

What is Evelyn's 'trick of the trade' for ensuring the team continues to work well together? "Respecting and loving each other through the ups and downs," she states. "Team members jump in when tragedies hit. And they're professional – they don't share one another's stories." She also believes that each person needs to have "real healing" before joining the team. "This is not for the faint of heart," she explains. Then she quickly jumps into the beauty of seeing retreatants transformed over the weekend. "The participants leave the retreat knowing that God, through His Mercy, does truly love and forgive them. They come out of their

cocoons like butterflies. They have peace; they have forgiven themselves. It's watching a miracle happen right before my eyes every time."

Through Rachel's Vineyard, Evelyn is able to "love those who feel unlovable." That's what keeps her in this ministry. It's what fuels her to stay strong when difficulties arise. It's what strengthens her own faith. And that faith is at the core of everything she does. Keeping her eyes "fixed on Jesus," Evelyn gives all credit to Him. After all, as she states simply and beautifully, "We're just his humble servants."

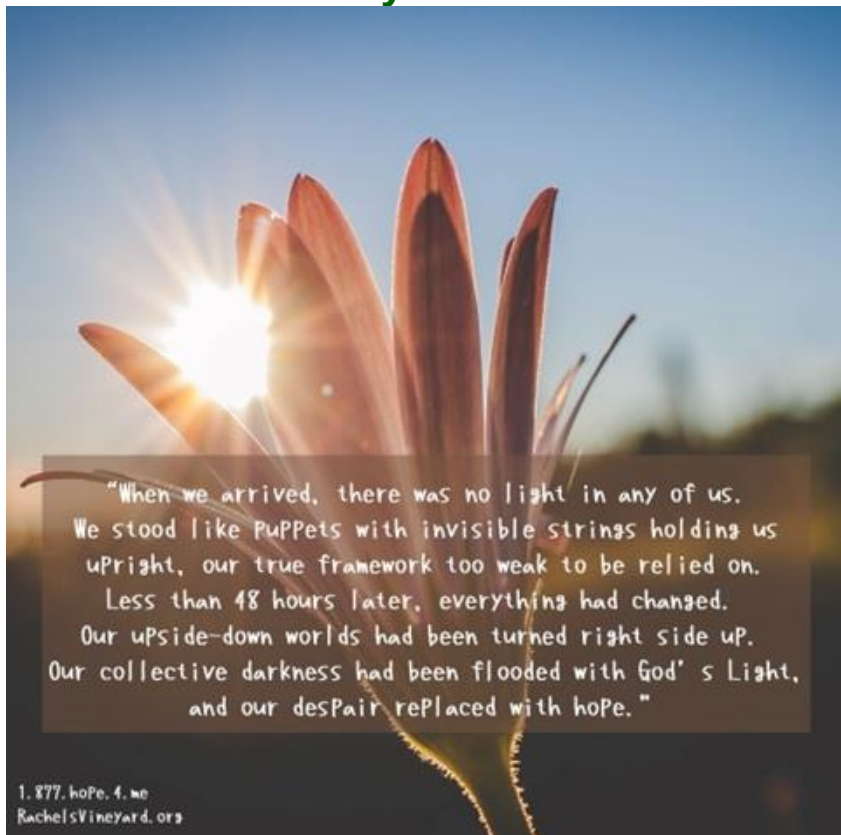
